Video Presentation and Discussion in complex C section cases

The focus is mainly on myometrial defects with placental intrusion (uterine dehiscence and spectrum of placental accreta), including patients with difficulty accessing the abdomen (multiple cesareans) and those at risk of hemorrhage or with established hemorrhage (placenta previa, broad ligament hematoma, ectopic pregnancy, etc.).

The audience will participate in this interactive session in video which will present operations:

- High hysterotomy to prevent myometrial defects
- Uterine compression sutures
- Paramedian access to the pelvis in case of abdominal wall fibrosis
- Repair of myometrial defects during cesarean section
- High hysterotomy to prevent myometrial defects
- Uterine tamponade with a hydrostatic balloon during cesarean section
- Control of broad ligament hematoma
- Uterine tourniquet
- Intraoperative staging of myometrial defects with placental intrusion
- Repair of myometrial defects with sliding myometrial flap
- One-step conservative surgery for the spectrum of placental accreta
- Modified subtotal hysterectomy for the spectrum of placental accreta
- Protocolized management of postpartum hemorrhage with a checklist
- Conservative surgical management of cesarean scar pregnancy

10.00-13.00 Hands On and Practical Course (* Check timetable)

I. Hands On: Five (5) simulation stations, including the execution of surgical techniques useful in managing postpartum hemorrhage. Participants will be divided in 5 groups.

Simulation stations are 30 minutes long plus 5 minutes for rotation.

II. Practical Course: Abnormal placentation image case scenarios, interactive testing and image quiz

In the **Hands On** you will be trained in the following topics:

- **Internal manual aortic compression:**

1. You will learn the indications and the correct technique to apply this effective and universally available strategy for the control of pelvic bleeding.
2. You will apply a step-by-step protocol to replicate what you have learned with your work team.

- **Compressive sutures for the lower uterine segment:**

1. you will identify the importance of mobilizing the bladder to correctly apply the compressive uterine sutures.
2. You will practice the transverse B Lynch suture (B Lynch 2) useful for controlling bleeding associated with placenta previa

- **Bakri Balloon Placement**

1. You will learn the correct technique and practical tips to apply Bakri Balloon in PPH cases after vaginal birth or in uterine atony in complex c section cases.
2. You will apply Bakri Ballon following a step-by-step protocol in mannequin.

- **Modified subtotal hysterectomy:**

1. You will practice each step of this surgical technique useful in severe cases of PAS in which it is impossible to separate the uterus from the bladder.
2. You will use a fabric uterus mannequin to internalize the concepts previously discussed in the theoretical session.

- **One Step Conservative Surgery:**

1. You will practice each step of this uterine conservation technique at PAS
2. You will use a material uterus mannequin to internalize the concepts previously discussed in the theoretical session

Surgeon, a researcher in placenta accreta spectrum, obstetric hemorrhage, and uterine repair. Associate Physician at CEMIC University Hospital; Buenos Aires, Argentina. Placental Magnetic Resonance Consultant at south Scientific Foundation, Lomas de Zamora, Argentina; Head Anatomy Professor at School of Medicine, University of Buenos Aires, Argentina. Invited Professor at Airlangga University, Indonesia. Fellow ad eundem of the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynecology. Member of the Argentine and International Societies of Obstetrics and Gynecology. Author of more than 150 indexed peer review publications, 12 books, and chapters, and received 9 national and international awards.



Albaro José Nieto-Calvache

is an obstetrician specializing in teaching and intensive care. He works in Colombia and leads the Placenta Accreta Spectrum (PAS) Program at Fundacion Valle de Lili. He has a special interest in the difficulties faced by women with PAS in resource-limited settings and has focused his research efforts on this topic on which he has published more than 70 scientific papers. He is also professor at the ICESI University in Colombia. Dr Nieto-Calvache is part of the Latin American Group for the Study of the Placental Accreta Spectrum, as well as other scientific societies focused on PAS (IS-PAS and PAS2).
